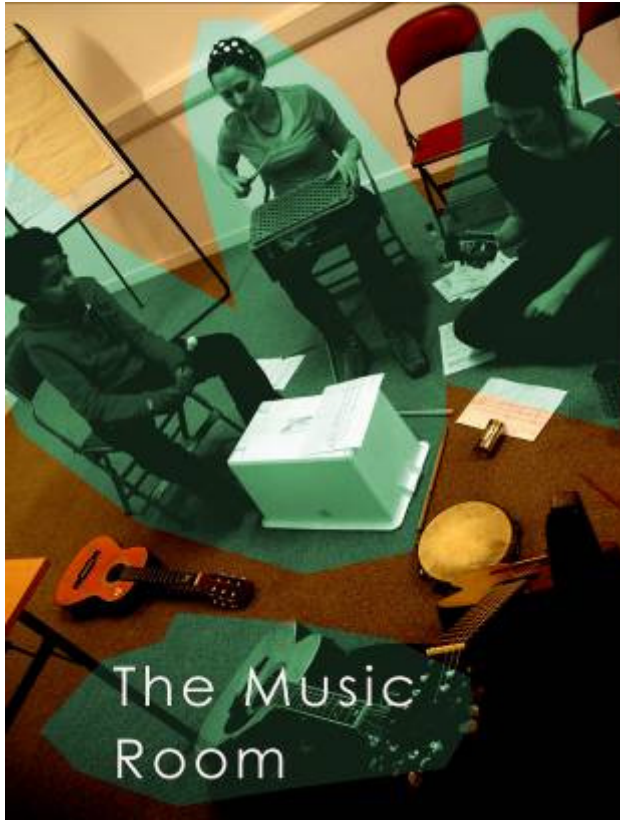




### **In case you didn't know already...**

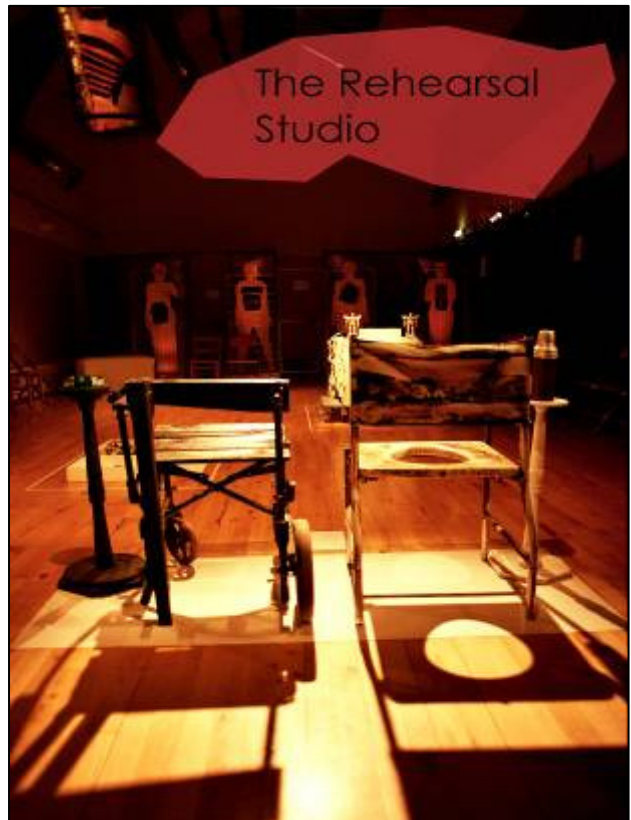


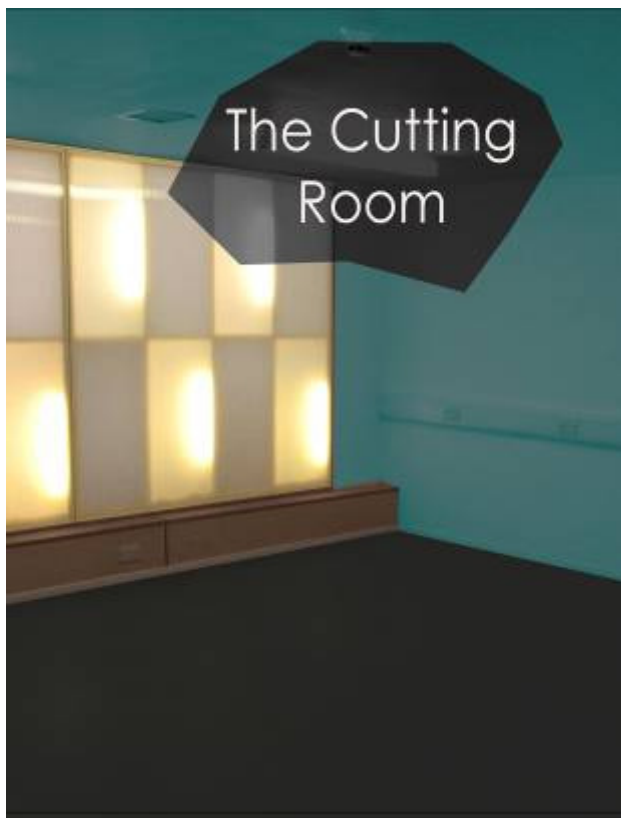
### **The Music Room (Ground Floor, Main Hall, Phase 3 new-built)**

The Music Room is our premium music rehearsal space. Fully insulated and ventilated, it's perfect for those who either need some quiet to concentrate or those who need to make a lot of noise! At 32 square metres it is large enough to accommodate group music lessons, workshops and drum circles as well as regular band practices. We are currently offering the room with a selection of amplifiers, a drum kit, small PA and a piano – users are welcome to bring their own gear too. We also appreciate the value of an uncluttered creative headspace so you'll find the room clean and minimally decorated, perfect for getting the most out of your time.

### **The Rehearsal Studio**

The Rehearsal Studio is a purpose built dance and drama studio, complete with a sprung wooden floor, floor to ceiling mirrors and underfloor heating. At around 80 square metres, the space can accommodate large groups for any purpose - capoeira classes, children's puppet shows and successful performances at the Edinburgh Fringe have all found a home here in the past.



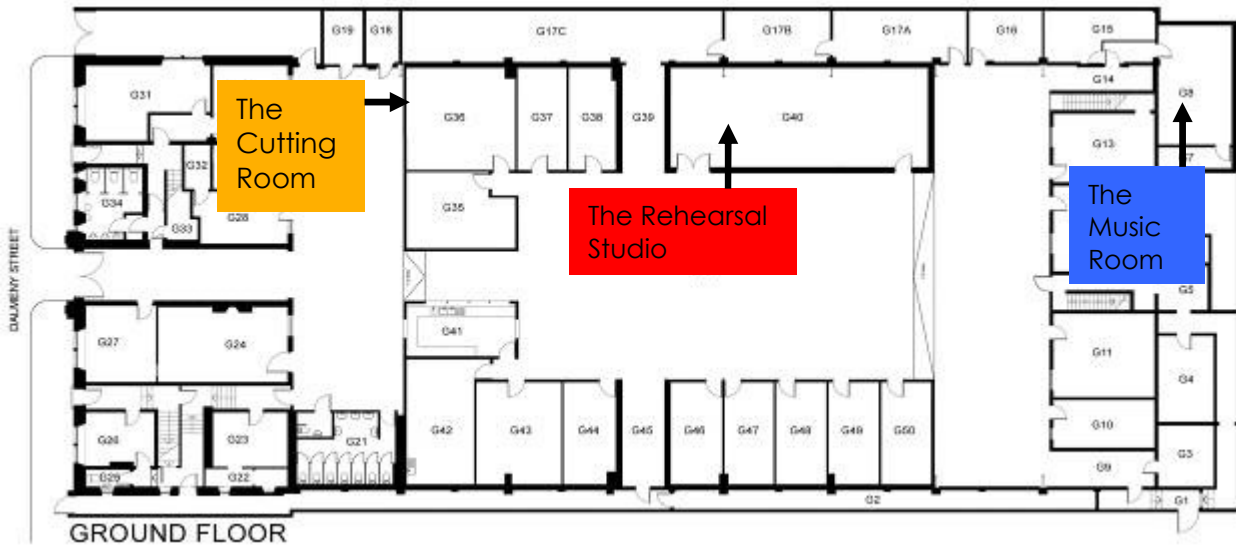


**The Cutting Room (Ground Floor, Main Hall, Phase 2 new-built)**

The Cutting Room is a smart and modern studio space measuring around 40 square metres. For musicians, it is well suited to evening practice for acoustic ensembles or group music lessons and the ambient lighting lends itself to yoga classes

Should you wish to book for an all day workshop or event, catering can be arranged in advance from the café, which serves freshly prepared food every day. AV equipment is also available for hire – please see the list attached below.
